ed his first store at 153 Main street on April 14, 1874.

Eight years later he erected the building now known as the Hoover building at 160 Main street, and moved between the closing hour and opened in the new building on time the next day. He remained in this location for thirty years.

He then incorporated and erected the building at 156 Main street, known as the Flock building.
