

## Silas Foster.

Silas Foster, aged fifty-three years, son of the late Samual and Eliza Foster, died at Warren Hospital on Friday, May 23. He had been afflicted from childhood from the effects of infantile paralysis, and death came from a severe stroke on Wednesday, from which he did not regain consciousness.

Mr. Foster was born in Hackettstown and always made his home here, working for Dr. A. C. Van-Syckle and Dr. Levi Farrow for a number of years. Then he had a horse-drawn taxi for seven years, until his health would not permit him to continue. He has made his home with his aunt, Mrs. Robert Grant, at 269 Main street, for the past eleven years, where the funeral services took place on Monday afternoon, conducted by the Rev. John S. Burton, pastor of the Methodist Episcopal Church. Interment was in Union Cemetery.
