

Ben Foulk Dead In Ky.

A Requiem Mass will be conducted this morning at 9:35 for Benjamin R. Foulk Jr., 22, of 189 Maple Avenue, Hackettstown, who was found dead in an automobile in Murray, Ky. on December 6. The Rev. Stephen A. Bielen will officiate at St. Mary's Church of the Assumption. Interment will be in Union Cemetery, Hackettstown.

Max Churchill, Murray County (Ky.) coroner, said Mr. Foulk died of carbon monoxide asphyxiation.

Funeral arrangements were handled by the Metzler Funeral Home in Hackettstown.

A senior at Murray State University in Murray, Ky., Mr. Foulk was majoring in psychology.

Born June 24, 1950 in Newton, he was a son of Mrs. Mary Mangiacotti Foulk of Hackettstown and the late Benjamin R. Foulk.

A graduate of Hackettstown High School, he was a member of St. Mary's Church of the Assumption here. He belonged to the Alpha Tau Omega fraternity and the Loyal Order of Moose at Murray.

In addition to his mother, he is survived by a brother, Captain William Foulk, stationed with the U.S. Army at Presidio of San Francisco in California; and three sisters, Mrs. Judith
