

Frank Fowler dies, ex-Hackettstown mayor

HACKETTSTOWN — Funeral services were held Thursday for Frank L. Fowler, 71, of 115 Church St., who died Monday at Hackettstown Community Hospital following a short illness.

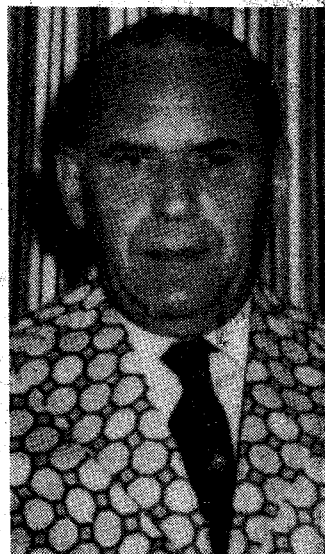
Mr. Fowler was born in Chicago. He resided in Hackettstown since 1948, moving here from Long Island.

He retired in 1977 as vice president of sales for Triumph Machinery Co. in Hackettstown.

Mr. Fowler served as mayor of Hackettstown in 1961. After suffering a heart attack, he resigned as mayor in January, 1962. In accepted his resignation, council named him honorary mayor for the balance of his term.

Mr. Fowler was a member of the Trinity Methodist Church Choir. He was a member of the Hackettstown Republican Club.
