Everett Freeman, 72, of Main Street in Hackettstown, died Friday at the Hackettstown Community Hospital after a long illness.

He was self-employed as a carpenter before retiring in 1983.

Born March 11, 1917, in Newark, he was the son of the late Everett A. and Charlotte Franke Freeman. He lived in Hackettstown for 20 years, moving there from Mendham.
