

Death of Mrs. A. G. Freeman.

Mrs. Hattie A. Freeman, widow of the late Dr. A. G. Freeman, formerly of this place, died suddenly at her home in Dover last Friday evening. In the afternoon she was out driving with a neighbor, and returned home about 5 o'clock. When her daughter, Miss Minerva, returned from school, she entered the dining room and spoke to her mother, who was sitting on a couch. Receiving no reply, she called to her sister, Miss Harriet, who was upstairs. They both called to their mother, but she made no answer. Neighbors were hastily summoned and a physician sent for, but ere he arrived Mrs. Freeman had expired. Death was due to apoplexy. She is survived by three children, the Misses Minerva and Harriet, and son, Lon.

Funeral services were held at the house Monday afternoon. Interment at Succunsumma beside her husband.

At 6:30 that evening her daughter, Miss Hattie, was married.
