

**Marion A. Freeman,
teacher for 42 years**

Marion A. Freeman, 86, of Hackettstown, died Tuesday, Feb. 10, in Forest Manor Nursing Home in Frelinghuysen Township.

She was a schoolteacher for the Hackettstown Board of Education for 40 years before retiring in 1972. Previously she taught for two years in Forks Township.

Born June 30, 1911, in Millville, Pa., she was a daughter of the late Rev. Frederick A. and Elizabeth M. Titus Goeller. She lived in Hackettstown most of her life, moving from Millville.

She was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church in Hackettstown.
