Mervin L. Fritz, 55, of Hackettstown, died March 17 at his home.

Born July 17, 1944 in Phoenixville, Pa., he was the son of Mervin Fritz and Esther Sabo Fritz, both of Royersford, Pa. He moved to Hackettstown in 1963, coming from Royersford.

He was an industrial tech teacher for over 20 years at the Chester M. Stephens Middle School in Mount Olive. Prior to that he taught at Briarcliff Middle School in Mountain Lakes from 1973-1982. He was also employed as a Park Ranger at Stephens State Park since 1983. He received a bachelor of science degree from Kean College in 1972.

He was a member of the Morris County Education Association, the NJEA, the National Rifle Association, and the Allamuchy Gun Club. He also was a member of Emanuel Bible Church in Schooley's Mountain.

Survivors include his wife, Delia Vail Fritz, of Hackettstown; a daughter, Delia Fritz, a student at Indiana University in Bloomington, Ind.; two brothers, Ronald, of Pottstown, Pa, and Herbert, of Royersford.
