Services were held for Anthony Frontera, 82, of Hackettstown, who died Nov. 17 at the Andover Intermediate Care Center after a short illness.

Mr. Frontera was born in Calabria, Italy, and lived in Chicago until he moved to the Hackettstown area in 1936.
