WASHINGTON TWP. (Morris)—Teresa M. Gannon, former auctioneer, died yesterday at Hackettstown Community Hospital after a long illness. She was 76.

She was a lifelong resident of the Long Valley section of the township.

Mrs. Gannon was recognized as the first woman auctioneer in New Jersey by the Auctioneers Association of New Jersey, of which she was a member. She was self-employed, trading in the Long Valley area as Gannon Auctioneering for 20 years.
