WILLIAM S. GILES.

William Schooley Giles died at the men's hospital in the Town Hall early last Saturday morning. The week previous he was smitten with smallpox and was taken to the hospital for treatment. He was getting along very well until he had a stroke of paralysis which resulted in his death.

The deceased was born December 3rd, 1826, and was the oldest son of Abram and Elizabeth Giles. In October, 1869, he married Margaret Daniley. He followed farming during the greater part of his life. In 1879 he became blind from an injury to one of his eyes, since which time he has resided in Hackettstown. Besides a wife he is survived by five children: Augustus C., of Morristown; Harry, of Dover; William S., Jr., Daisy and Lucy A. at home.
