

EUGENE GLENNON

Services were held Saturday morning at the Cochran Funeral Home on High Street and then at Our Lady of the Mountain Church, Schooley's Mountain for Eugene P. Glennon, Hackettstown realtor who died suddenly last Wednesday, September 19, at his home on Asbury Road, Independence Township. Burial was in the adjoining cemetery on Schooley's Mountain.

Born May 6, 1929 on Long Island, Mr. Glennon was a son of the late Michael S. and Delia Fannon Glennon. He had lived since childhood in the Hackettstown area and was a graduate of Hackettstown High School, Class of 1947.

Mr. Glennon was the last to fill the coroner's office in Warren County before the post was abolished in 1968. Prior to that he had been elected five times as a Democrat.

For 11 years following high school he was employed as a produce manager with Acme Markets and then operated the former Little Chef Luncheonette for a year on Route 46 and East Avenue.

Mr. Glennon had been engaged in real estate sales since 1959 and had operated his own broker's office since May of 1967, currently in his building at 188 Main Street at the corner of Moore.

He was a member of the Warren County Board of Realtors and the local board of the Suburban Savings & Loan Association. He had formerly belonged to the Kiwanis club and the Hackettstown Grange.

Surviving are his wife, the former Dorothy Suss, and a daughter, Sharon Ann, at home.
