

Eugene Glennon, Realtor, Dead at 44

Eugene B. Glennon, 44, Hackettstown, realtor and the last person to serve as Warren County coroner, died suddenly at his home on Asbury Road, Independence Township, yesterday (Wednesday) morning.

Funeral arrangements are being made by the Cochran

Funeral Home, Hackettstown. Mr. Glennon served five terms as a Warren County coroner before that post was abolished in 1968.

Born in Long Island, he lived in Hackettstown all of his life. He was graduated from Hackettstown High School in 1947.

He was employed for 11 years as produce manager with the Acme Markets. Leaving that post in 1958, he owned and operated the former Little Chef Luncheonette at Route 46 and East Avenue for a year before selling the site to Texaco.

He was engaged in real estate sales since 1959 and has had his own broker's office at 188 Main Street, since May, 1967.

He formerly was a member of the Hackettstown Kiwanis Club and the Hackettstown Grange.

Survivors include his widow, the former Dorothy Suss, and a daughter, Sharon Ann.
