

HERMAN B. GOOD, LEATHER MAN DIES

Herman B. Good, president of Good Brothers Leather Co., of Newark, died Tuesday morning at his home, 9 Kingman Road, South Orange, after a long illness. He leaves his wife and two children, Mrs. Gerard K. Lind, of Orange, and Carl F. Good, of South Orange. The son was associated with him in business. He was 71 years old.

Mr. Good and his brother, Robert C. Good, of Morristown, also controlled the Lackawanna Leather Co. of Hackettstown. He was born in Shephardsville, Ky. Before coming to Newark Mr. Good learned the tanning trade in Cincinnati and was with the American Oak Leather Co. there. His business life in Newark covered more than 40 years.

The Lackawanna Leather Company was closed from 11 A. M. until 1 P. M., during the funeral services of Mr. Good, which took place on Thursday.
