

Robert Charles Good

Robert Charles Good of Normandie Park, Morristown, founder and president of the Lackawanna Leather Company of Hackettstown, died at Skytop, Pa., Tuesday night at the Skytop Club of heart disease at the age of 77.

Born in Shepherdsville, Ky., Mr. Good was educated in Paris and began his business career in Cincinnati with the American Oak Leather Co. He then became associated with his brother, the late Herman G. Good, in Newark. He was president of the Good Brothers Leather Co., of Newark, and of the Lackawanna Leather Co., Ltd., of Toronto. He leaves a widow, Geraldine T. Good, a daughter, Mrs. Bertha G. Dimm of South Orange, and two sons, Richard R., of Newark, and Donald S. Good of Hackettstown, all children of his first wife, the late Susan F. Good.

Funeral services will be held at his late home this (Friday) afternoon at two o'clock and interment will be in Evergreen Cemetery, Morristown.
