Harry Grace

Harry Grace, 84, formerly of Hackettstown, died Aug. 22, in Miami Springs, Fla.

Born in Hoboken, he was the son of the late William and Catherine (Clark) Grace.

The family moved to Hackettstown in 1919. He was a 1933 graduate of Hackettstown High School.

He was employed at the Hackettstown Post Office before joining the Marine Corps during World War II. His tour of duty took him to the Pacific Theater.

A Professional Golf Association (PGA) member, he worked at various country clubs in the Northeast including Fidler's Elbow in Whitehouse Station. He also served as the golf pro at
