ALLAMUCHY -- Providence Greco died Thursday evening, May 3, 2007 at the home of her daughter and son-in-law, Barbara and Jack Reed, following a long illness. She was 87.

She was born on Aug. 28, 1919, in Newark, the daughter of the late Michael and Frances (Massina) Leta.

She resided in Irvington for 70 years. She lived in Hackettstown since 1990, and for the past two years she had resided in Allamuchy with her daughter and son-in-law.
