

## Retired Teacher In Independence Dies At Age 78

Services were held Saturday at the Coogan Funeral Home in Hackettstown for Mrs. Euphemia L. Green, 78, a retired school teacher who spent 41 years in her profession.

A resident of 404 Church Street in Hackettstown, Mrs. Green died last Wednesday, March 8, 1972, at Morristown Memorial Hospital after a long illness.

The funeral was conducted by her pastor, the Rev. J. H. Criswell of the First Presbyterian Church of Hackettstown, and burial was in the Hazen Cemetery.

Born in Glen Gardner, Mrs. Green was a daughter of the late Henry and Caroline Praster Lanterman. She grew up in Oxford and started teaching in 1911 following her graduation from high school there. She continued with summer studies at Ocean City for certification.

Mrs. Green retired in 1963 after 41 years of teaching, including 17 years at Central School, Independence Township. She also taught at Pequest, Oxford and White Township.

Mrs. Green was a member of the Order of the Eastern Star, Chapter No. 102, in Hackettstown.

Her husband, Edward T. Green, died several years ago. She is survived by three sons, Dr. Edward of Oneida, N. Y., Gerald of Unadilla, N. Y., and Philip of Hackettstown; a daughter, Mrs. Gerald V. Nye of Olean, N. Y.; a sister, Mrs. Walter Cooper of Phillipsburg; 14 grandchildren and one great grandchild.
