First Lt. William G. Groeger, 24, of Lonesome Trail, Georgetown, Texas, died Saturday from injuries suffered in an auto accident in Georgetown.

He was serving with the U.S. Army, stationed at Fort Hood, Texas.

Born in Morristown, N.J., he was a son of Karl and Elizabeth Zellars Groeger of Pleasant Grove, N.J. He lived in Pleasant Grove until moving to Texas in 1983.

A 1979 graduate of West Morris Central High School, he graduated from the U.S. Military Academy, West Point, in 1983, where he was on the dean's list and served as a brigade captain.

Lt. Groeger was a member of Pleasant Grove Presbyterian Church.

Surviving in addition to his parents are his wife, the former Patricia Howard; two brothers, Karl III of Long Branch, N.J., and Andrew, at home, who will be attending West Point in July; a sister, Liese Groeger, at home; maternal grandmother, Mrs. Jessie Zellars, Pleasant Grove, and his paternal grandmother, Mrs. Theresa Groeger, Trenton, N.J.
