

Florence D. Grogan, 103; Active In Hackettstown

NEWTON — Florence D. Grogan, Franklin Street, formerly of Hackettstown, died Sunday at Newton Memorial Hospital after a short illness. She was 103.

Mrs. Grogan was born in Hackettstown and lived most of her life there before moving here 10 years ago.

While in Hackettstown, Mrs. Grogan lived on High Street in the house she and her late husband, Charles, built themselves in 1907 across from St. Mary's Church of the Assumption.

Mrs. Grogan was the oldest living member of Trinity United Methodist Church, Hackettstown, had been a member of the church's Friendly Bible Class, and had been active in church affairs.

Mrs. Grogan was a charter member of the Hackettstown Woman's Club. At a recent meeting in Hackettstown, she was honored for her work with the club. During the early days of the club, she and other charter members held meetings in their own homes. She also hosted card parties in her home to help start the Hackettstown Free Public Library.

Mrs. Grogan was an 1894 graduate of Hackettstown High

School, one of the first graduating classes of the school.

She leaves a daughter, Aileen Boole, with whom she lived, one grandchild and two great-grandchildren.
