

Former Official Dies At 77

HACKETTSTOWN — Former Councilman Frank M. Groover, 77, died yesterday at Hackettstown Community Hospital after a long illness.

Groover served as a Democratic councilman here from 1966-69, and 1972-75.

Born in Blairstown, he had lived here since 1935. His address was 301 Franklin St.

He was a road foreman for the Salmon Bros. Construction Co., Netcong, where he had worked for 51 years before retiring in 1974.

He was a member of the Trinity United Methodist Church of Hackettstown; Elks Lodge No. 2131, where he had been a past-exalted ruler; the Washington Moose Lodge; the Hackettstown Rotary Club; and a former member of the Hackettstown Municipal Utilities Authority.
