

## JOHN R. GROVER

46, of 505 Washington Street, was stricken with a heart attack on Saturday, February 22, 1947, near Broadway, while attempting to free his car which was stuck in the snow. He was taken to the office of Dr. David M. Shevitz in Hackettstown, where he was pronounced dead. Coroner Paul Ford of Washington issued a certificate of death.

Mr. Grover, the son of William H. Grover of Allamuchy and the late Mrs. Ella Hawk Grover, was born in Allamuchy. He was employed by M. B. Bowers and Son for eight years and had previously worked for many years at the Robert Teel hardware store in Hackettstown.

In addition to his father, he is survived by his wife, Mrs. Helen Park Grover; a son, Harold W. Grover, and a daughter, Miss Margaret Grover, at home; two brothers, Ernest, of Allamuchy, and Charles, of Hackettstown, and two sisters, Mrs. Ernest Barrett, of Allamuchy, and Mrs. Dana Appleman, of Sparta.

Funeral services, in charge of Clinton S. Hiles of Great Meadows, were held yesterday afternoon from his late home with the Rev. Andrew M. Sebben of First Presbyterian Church, officiating. Interment was in Pequest Union Cemetery.
