

NELSON T. GRUENDYKE

Funeral services were held Monday afternoon at the Cochran Funeral Home for Nelson T. Gruendyke, 78, of 312 Willow Grove Street, Hackettstown, who died after a long illness in Morristown Memorial Hospital on Thursday, September 21, 1961. He was hospitalized seven days.

Mr. Gruendyke formerly operated a trucking business. He was retired.

Born June 10, 1883, in Hackettstown, he was a son of the late Daniel and Elizabeth Trimmer Gruendyke. He was a lifelong resident of Hackettstown. His wife, the former Emma Sidner, died in 1959.

Mr. Gruendyke was a member of Cataract Hose Co. No. 1 of the Hackettstown Fire Department and the Exempt Fireman's Association of New Jersey.
