While in Tampa Maggie lived on Wheeling Drive in Carollwood at Logan Gate for 24 years, she dearly loved and was loved by her neighborhood "family" and is remembered to this day for her daily walks, beautiful smile, kind words and honorary-appointment as neighborhood watch chief. In 2010 she briefly moved to Aston Gardens and in 2011 moved to Los Angeles, California living at Silverado Senior Living-Beverly Place where she remained until her passing. She enjoyed spending time and holidays with her family and friends, attending various family events in Tampa, Atlanta and Los Angeles, Maggie loved westerns, cookies and, sometimes, ice cream for dinner.
