

Arthur Guarino; Accident Victim

HACKETTSTOWN — Funeral services were held Tuesday for 14-year-old Arthur Guarino, of 207 Mountain Ave., who was struck by a car Friday while playing in a street.

Guarino was playing with a friend near 9 Seymour Terr. when he was struck by a car driven by William Muehlbach of 28 Seymour Terr. He was pronounced dead on arrival at Hackettstown Community Hospital at about 4:50 p.m.

According to police, Muehlbach apparently didn't see the boy until he was about 10 feet away. Guarino's friend told them Guarino ran from in front of a parked car and into the street.

An honor student in the eighth grade at the Middle School here, he was class treasurer and a recipient of the President's Physical Fitness Award. Last year he won a state mathematics award.

A basketball and football player, he belonged to the 4-H and Downhillers Ski Club. He enjoyed working in the bicycle shop owned by his stepfather, Angelo Scavone.

Survivors include his father, Michael, Warren; his mother, Mrs. Antoinette Del Bagno Scavone; a brother, Joseph, Lyndhurst; two step-brothers, Raymond, Parsippany, and Michael, Bloomfield; a step-sister, Mrs. Diane Brundage of Lake Hiawatha; his maternal grandmother, Mrs. Tomasina Del Bagno and his paternal grandmother, Mrs. Rose Sauchelli, of Belleville.

Funeral services were conducted from the Cochran Funeral Home, 905 High Street, Hackettstown, to a Mass of the Resurrection at St. Mary's Church of the Assumption.

Interment was in Hackettstown Union Cemetery.
