

Death of William Hairhouse.

William Hairhouse died last Sunday afternoon at the home of his father, Charles Hairhouse, on Hope street, in the forty-ninth year of his age. He had been critically ill about ten days from peritonitis, which was followed by other diseases. The deceased was born in this place and his whole life was spent here, being an assistant to his father in the jewelry business. He never married and always lived at home. He was one of the few remaining charter members of Cataract Hose Co., No. 1. Besides his father he is survived by one brother, Charles P. Hairhouse, of Newark, and two sisters, Mrs. George W. Smith and Mrs. Charles Rittenhouse, of this place. Funeral services were held at his late home Wednesday afternoon, Rev. J. M. Hunting officiating. The members of the fire department attended in a body. Interment in the family plot in Union cemetery.
