

DANIEL S. HARRIS

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon in Trinity Methodist Church for Daniel S. Harris, 73, who died of a cerebral hemorrhage at his home in Clearwater, Fla., on Thursday, October 11, 1951. Dr. Chester A. Pennington, a former pastor of Trinity Methodist Church, officiated at the rites, assisted by Dr. Fred C. Mooney, pastor emeritus of the Danville Presbyterian Church, Great Meadows. Burial was in Hackettstown Union Cemetery.

Mr. Harris, a Hackettstown clothing merchant for 22 years, retired a few years ago and had moved to Clearwater 10 months ago. For many years he and his brother, James A. Harris, also of Town, operated a clothing store on Main Street as a partnership until 1934. Later James A. Harris was alone in the business until his retirement, August 15.

Born in Independence Township, Mr. Harris was a son of the late William and Pernina Ayers Harris. He was a former president of the Hackettstown Board of Education and Union Cemetery Association. He was a member of Trinity Methodist Church and a former president of the Official Board.

Survivors in addition to his brother are his wife, Mrs. Margaret Hartman Harris; a daughter, Mrs. William Dittig of Trenton; a son, Daniel S. Harris, Jr., of Swarthmore, Pa., and five grandchildren.
