

OBITUARY

Mrs. Lucinda L. Hart, eighty-two years old, was stricken Wednesday morning of a heart attack and death resulted suddenly. She had been in usual health other than the infirmities of advanced age. Her husband, Jacob C. Hart, died seven years ago, and the following children survive: Mrs. Edward N.
