 Funeral services were conducted on Friday, June 15, 1972, at 10:00 a.m. from the funeral home of Mine Hill Road, Hackettstown, who died on Saturday, June 10, 1972, at Barnes Hospital in Memphis after suffering a brain hemorrhage. Interment was in Millington.
