DEATH OF MR. S. S. HARVEY.—Silas Harvey, eldest son of Levi and Sarah Harvey, of Ironia, N. J., a native of Morris county, died at his residence in Chancery, Montana, on Wednesday, May 7th. Mr. Harvey was born in July, 1826; he studied and prepared for college, but his health being poor he was obliged to give up study and taught school for a few years; he afterwards followed the mercantile business successfully at Shippingport and Hackettstown. He also drove on the brewery at this place for several years. About 12 years ago he moved to Montana in search of gold, where he also engaged extensively in the stock-raising business. His health failed four or five years ago, but he had attended to business until the past few months. He was widely known and respected in this State. He died of consumption, and leaves an aged father and mother, wife and four children to mourn his loss.
