Sterling E. Haskell, 82, formerly from Northeast Harbor, died July 5, 2013, in Hackettstown, N.J. He was born May 15, 1931, at Mount Desert Island Hospital, Bar Harbor, to Dr. G. Merrill and Mildred (VanDerKar) Haskell of Northeast Harbor, where Sterling grew up.

Sterling graduated from Gould Academy, Bethel, in 1949, and RCA Institute in New York City, in 1952. For many years he worked for Vast, Inc., Waldoboro, as an electronics design engineer.
