

## Death of Frank Hayward.

Frank W. Hayward, second son of Mr. and Mrs. Edward Hayward, of this town, died suddenly of acute indigestion at his home in Sussex last Sunday. He had spent Saturday afternoon at the ball game and in automobiling, and retired as well as usual. He was taken with great distress after midnight, a bad heart complicating the condition, and he died the next afternoon. He was born in Hackettstown and enjoyed wide popularity here. He was with both Rea and Shields, graduated from the New York College of Pharmacy, and fourteen years ago entered the employ of Lawrence, the wholesale and retail druggist at Deckertown, now Sussex. He became a partner in the firm under the firm name of Lawrence & Hayward. The partnership was a recognition of his professional ability and wide personal popularity. Three years ago he was married to Miss Mabel Cole, and she, with a little daughter, survives him.

Mr. Hayward was a member of Samaritan Lodge, F. and A. M.; Polaski Lodge, I. O. O. F., and Court Sussex, I. O. F. The funeral services were held at the home on Wednesday afternoon. Rev. E. E. Loux, of the First Baptist church, officiating. Interment was at Sussex in Papakating Cemetery.
