

MRS. MORRIS J. HEFLEY,  
HACKETTSTOWN — Mrs.  
Mable Fleming Hefley, 87, of  
Hackettstown, R.D. 1, died  
suddenly Friday morning of a  
heart attack in Hackettstown  
Community Hospital where she  
had been admitted the previous  
day. She was the widow of  
Morris James Hefley who died  
in 1945.

Mrs. Hefley was born in  
Bethlehem Township, Hun-  
terdon County. A resident of  
Elizabeth most of her life, she  
had made her home with a  
daughter, Mrs. Richard G. M.  
Hull on Schooley's Mountain for  
the last five years.

A daughter of the late George  
and Esther Ann Green Fleming,

numerous Colonial families.  
She was a former member of  
the Boudinot D.A.R. Chapter of  
Elizabeth.
