JACOB HERRE.

Mr. Jacob Herre, died in this place on Monday the 14th inst., of consumption, at the age of 47 years, 8 months and 2 days.

Mr. Herre was born in Waile bach, Wurtenberg, near Stuttgart, Germany, on June 15th, 1830, and came to this country in 1856, settling in this town, where he resided up to the time of his death. He was a tailor by trade, and followed his occupation until about six years ago, when the dreaded disease consumption fastened itself upon him and he was compelled to quit his trade. He had been confined to his bed about eight months, and suffered most terribly. Mr. Herre was a member of the Masonic Order of this place, of which one of the brethren of the Order visited him during his illness once a day for fifteen weeks.

He was a loved and respected busband, a kind father and an amiable and highly respected citizen. He leaves a wife and two daughters, the oldest being Mrs. Mary Dickson, and the youngest Miss Gussie Herre, to mourn his demise. The funeral took place on Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock from his late residence on Rockport street, the Rev. Alex. Proudfit officiating. The interment took place at Union Cometery, the burial services being conducted in a solemn and impressive manner by the Masonic Order.
