Graveside services were arranged for Mary L. Hetherington, 90, of the House of the Good Shepherd, Hackettstown, who died there March 15 after a short illness.

She was born in Milwaukee and lived in Maplewood before moving to Hackettstown in 1979.

She was a librarian in the Maplewood Public Library from 1923 to 1964.

She was a graduate of Northwestern University, class of 1923, and a member of the Hackettstown Historical Society and the American Association of University Women of Washington, D.C.
