

Frances B. Hock, retired nurse

Frances B. Hock, 94, of Heath Village in Hackettstown, died Thursday, Aug. 22, in Hackettstown Community Hospital.

She was a nurse in Lt. Luke's Hospital in New York City.

Born April 20, 1902, in New York City, she was a daughter of the late James and Letitia J. Nelson Bussell. She resided in Heath Village since 1985. Prior to that, she resided in Ridgewood, N.J., where she and her late husband lived for 50 years.

She was a graduate of the Lt. Luke's Hospital School of Nursing in New York City. She practiced nursing there and elsewhere prior to her marriage.

She was a volunteer nurse in the Ridgewood Civil Defense Program serving in World War II. She was a founding member of the Ridgewood Nurses Guild. She also taught Red Cross home nursing courses in Ridgewood, where she was an active member of St. Elizabeth's Episcopal Church.

Her husband, W. Fletcher, died in 1986.

She is survived by a son, W. Fletcher Jr. of Ridgewood; a daughter, Sarah H. Coxhead of Warwick, N.Y.; and four grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at 11 a.m. Tuesday in St. James Episcopal Church in Hackettstown. There will be no calling hours.

Burial will be private.
