

Karl Hoff

Services were held Nov. 26 in All Saints of the Desert Episcopal Church, Sun City, Ariz., for Karl G. Hoff, 73, of Sun City, who died Nov. 22 at Walter Boswell Memorial Hospital, Sun City, after a long illness.

A former resident of Great Meadows, Mr. Hoff moved to Wheat Ridge, Colo., after his retirement in 1976, and had lived in Sun City for the past two years.

He was a 1930 graduate of Hackettstown High School and received a bachelor of science degree in agriculture in 1935 from Rutgers University, where he was a member of Lambda Chi Alpha fraternity. He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II.

During his lifetime, Mr. Hoff

pursued careers in landscape gardening, truck farming and electrical contracting, retiring in 1976. He had been secretary of the Sussex-Warren Electrical Contractors Association.

Mr. Hoff served as a member of both the Allamuchy and Independence township boards of education and was president of the latter board. He was tax assessor for Independence Township in 1963-64, and also was a charter member of the Independence Township First Aid Squad.

He was a communicant of All Saints Church.

Surviving are his wife, Dorothy; two daughters, Louise Carpenter of Great Meadows R.D., and Virginia Boyce of Sun City; his mother, Madge Hoff of Great Meadows R.D.; two brothers, John of Lake

Lenape, Andover, and David of Great Meadows R.D.; three grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Interment was in Pequest Union Cemetery, Great Meadows.
