W. A. Hoffman, 88, Expires In Hospital

Retired Merchant Spent 45 Years In Operation Of Hardware Store Here William A. Hoffman, who was engaged in the hardware business here on Main Street from 1900 to 1945, died on Tuesday, June 30, 1953, at the home of his sister-in-law, Mrs. Clifford Mills of Morristown, at the age of 83.

Mr. Hoffman was born at Hoffman's, Hunterdon County, on August 30, 1864, a sen of the late Abram and Anna Bunn Hoffman, His early life was spent there. Prior to the hardware business, Mr. Hoffman was engaged for a short period in the manufacture of peach buskets at Hoffman's and in the building and contracting business. He sold the hardware business on March 1, 1943, to Robert B. Allen.

On February 11, 1897, he was married to Miss Mae Weise Trunmer, daughter of Assemblyman L. H. Trummer and Mrs. Elizabeth Dutford Trimmer. The couple were residents at 407 Moore Street for many years. They sold their home in March. 1945, to Centenary Junior
