

Richard “Dick” A. Hogan Sr.

HACKETTSTOWN — Richard “Dick” A. Hogan Sr. of Hackettstown died Saturday, Dec. 9, 2006 at the House of the Good Shepherd, Hackettstown. He was 86.

Born Aug. 18, 1920 in Trenton, he was the son of the late Matthew Hogan and the late Mary (Groom) Hogan.

He moved to Long Valley in 1950 where he resided until 2003 and then moved to Hackettstown.

Dick was an industrial engineer at Picatinny Arsenal and retired in 1977.

He received his undergraduate degree at the University of Alabama and his Master's degree at Steven Tech in Hoboken.

He was a veteran of the U.S. Marine Corp, serving in the Pacific during World War II. He was an avid gardener and a former school board member in Washington Township. He was also a former member of the Washington Township Historical Society, the Golden Age Club of Long Valley and the Fifty Plus Club of Chester.

Survivors include his wife of 58 years, Helen Betty (Breece) Hogan of Hackettstown; three sons, Richard Jr. and his wife Elaine of Long Valley; Ethan and his wife Judith of Succasunna and Matthew and his wife Christine of Jefferson, Maryland; grandchildren Kristen and Kelly of Morristown; Ashley, Kimberly and Shane of Jefferson, Md; a sister, Margaret Black of Atco, NJ; and a niece, Muriel Bitten and her husband Keith of Riverton, NJ.

Visitation was held at the William J. Leber Funeral Home in Chester. Interment was private.
