Benjamin B. Howell.

Mr. Benjamin B. Howell, of whose serious illness we spoke last week, died at his home just out of the village of Vienna, last Sunday morning in the 62d year of his age.

Mr. Howell had been a life-long resident of the vicinity in which he died and by industry had acquired a pleasant and comfortable home, consisting of one of the best dairy farms in the Pequest Valley. He is survived by his wife and three children, Aaron, of Newark, Mrs. Isaac Hill, of Walnut Valley and Miss Howell, principal of the Allamuchy Public School. Two brothers, George, of Vienna, and John A. of Phillipsburg, and a half sister, Mrs. Hamilton, of Orange, also survive him.
