Mrs. Alice G. Hummer.

Mrs. Alice G. Hummer, widow of William A. Hummer, died June 3 at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Alvah Thomas, 408 Monroe street. She had reached the age of eighty years, and has resided with her daughter since the death of her husband twelve years ago.

She was the daughter of Peter Fisher, one time proprietor of the Belvidere Hotel, Belvidere. The first year of her married life was spent in Hackettstown, after which her home was in Phillipsburg up to the time of her husband's death.
