

Miriam Husk, kindergarten teacher

Miriam Husk, 97, of Heath Village in Washington Township, N.J., died Friday, Sept. 6, in Hackettstown Community Hospital.

She was a kindergarten teacher in Newark, retiring in 1963.

Born Aug. 24, 1899, in Newark, she was a daughter of the late Lewis E. and Araminta Speer Husk. She had been a resident of Heath Village since 1979. Prior to that, she was a resident of Morristown, N.J., and Newark.

She was a 1919 graduate of the Newark Normal school.

She graduated from New York University with a bachelor's degree in 1921 and in 1923 with a master's degree.

She is survived by three cousins.
