

MRS. JANE JACOBSEN
HACKETTSTOWN — Mrs. Jane Jacobsen of Rustic Knolls, Willow Grove Street, 60-year-old motivation therapist at The House of The Good Shepherd, died suddenly Friday at Hackettstown Community Hospital.

Born March 27, 1913 in Jersey City, Mrs. Jacobsen was a daughter of the late Robert and Rebecca Buchannon Galloway.
