WASHINGTON — Funeral services were held Sunday for Harold W. Jensen, 76, a thorough businessman active in community affairs, who died March 10 in Warren Hospital, Phillipsburg.

He lived at 115 Broad St.

At the time of his death, he was president of Jensen Realty Corp., Washington. In 1962, he retired as vice president and treasurer of Vikon Tile Corp., Washington. For 25 years he had owned Jensen's Sweet Shoppe here.

He served as a trustee of Cedar Crest College, Allentown for 15 years.

He was a past president of the Washington Chamber of Commerce and a former member of the municipal parking authority.

He attended New York University.

Born in Hackettstown, he was a son of the late James and Eleanor West Jensen.

He was a member and a former trustee of the First Presbyterian Church and a 50-year member of Mansfield Lodge 36, F&AM, both of Washington.

He and his wife, the former Helen Swisher, observed their 51st wedding anniversary in 1976.

Surviving in addition to his widow are three daughters,

Mrs. Joyce Long of Dallas, Tex.; Mrs. Jean Brenner of Durham, N.C., and Mrs. Janet Smith of Marcellus, N.Y.; a brother, Charles of Washington and seven grandchildren.

Services were held in the Ford Funeral Home, Washington.
