The Late Morris N. Johnson.

The body of the late Morris N. Johnson was brought here from New York City for burial in Union Cemetery on Tuesday. Funeral services were held Tuesday morning in the Collegiate Church of St. Nicholas, New York City. The deceased was the son of the late William Johnson and Catharine Trimmer. He attended Phillips Academy at Andover, Mass., and was graduated from Princeton University, in 1876, three years before President Woodrow Wilson, of whom he was a school friend. His official connections had been as follows: President of the International Ordnance Company, Secretary and Treasurer of the United States Ordnance and Projectile Company, and President of the Ontario Mining and Smelting Company. Mr. Johnson is survived by one sister, Mrs. Woods, wife of Judge Joseph Woods, of Lewistown. Pa., and by one brother, Geo. W. Johnson, of Hackettstown. Ill health had forced his retirement from active work.
