

Stewart Johnson, committeeman, dies

STEWART JOHNSON SR. INDEPENDENCE TWP. —

Funeral services were held Tuesday for Stewart S. Johnson Sr., 67, of Townsbury Road, who died Saturday at Hackettstown Community Hospital after a short illness.

Born Oct. 10, 1910, in Independence Township, he was a son of the late Wesley C. and May Ball Johnson. He was a lifelong area resident.

A retired farmer, he was a former member of the Warren County and state boards of

agriculture, and served as vice president of the state organization in 1971. A former member of the Independence Township Board of Education, he was a member of the township planning board at the time of his death. He had served that board since 1969.

He was a member of the Independence Lodge 42 F&AM, Hackettstown; the West Jersey Shrine Club, Phillipsburg; the Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite Valley of Trenton and was president

of the board of trustees of the Pequest Union Cemetery Association.

He is survived by his wife, the former Evelyn Engemann; a son, Stewart Jr. at home, and two sisters, Mrs. Kingdon Cleave of Wharton and Mrs. Leo Wisniski of Union.

Services were at the Cochran Funeral Home, Hackettstown.

Interment was in the Pequest Union Cemetery, Great Meadows.
