

OBITUARY

Mrs. Ann Johnston.

Full of years, "like a shock of corn that is ripe," Mrs. Ann Johnston, mother of Mr. Oscar Johnston, of the firm of Cline & Johnston, and of Mrs. Cline, wife of the senior member of that firm, passed away last Saturday afternoon at her daughter's home on their farm, known as the Menagh farm, at the advanced age of 87 years. It was a remarkable coincident that her death followed within a few hours a telegram announcing the death of her brother at Bordentown, in the 93d year of his age, and the two branches of the family met in sorrowful reunion at the interment of both at Port Jervis, N. Y., on Tuesday.

Mrs. Johnston has made her home with her daughter here for several years, but her advanced age and the weakness incident thereto have prevented her from forming any large circle of acquaintances. The funeral services were held at 4 p. m. on Monday at the house, and were conducted by Rev. J. C. Chapman of the Presbyterian church.
