

Death of Levi J. Johnston.

Levi J. Johnston, a former well known resident of Hackettstown, died at his home in New York last Sunday, aged 77 years. Deceased was of a family well known, and highly esteemed in this section, where many descendants of the family still reside. The other members of the family were John S. Johnston, most of whose life was spent on the Wagner Farm; Charles, whose only son, Clifford S., is still a resident; Armatage, whose widow and daughter have their home on Washington street, and Dr. Samuel, of Dover, who is the only brother surviving. The two sisters are Mrs. Alonzo Wire, wife of Policeman Wire, and Mrs. Charles Cox, who lives in Washington.

Mr. Johnston was succeeded in the shoe business by Ezra Ferris. He retained his membership in Independence Lodge F. & A. M., and a delegation composed of Worshipful Master Labar, James Tamblin, Richard Penhale and Robert Wallace attended the funeral on Wednesday and accompanied the remains to Morristown.
