

Frederick J. Jones

HACKETTSTOWN — Frederick J. Jones, 87, of Hackettstown died April 8, 2007 at Hackettstown Regional Medical Center.

Born in Philadelphia, Pa., he was a son of the late Roy Croft and Ina B. Vorce Jones.

Mr. Jones lived in Germantown, Pa., and Edgewater Park before moving to Hackettstown in 1977. He was a contract specialist at the Picatinny Arsenal in Rockaway

Township.

An Army veteran of World War II, Mr. Jones fought in the Battle of the Bulge with the 36th Infantry Division. He also saw combat in France and Germany.

He was very involved in activities at the House of the Good Shepherd in Hackettstown. A member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars and Civil Service Retirees, Mr. Jones was a lay reader assistant at St.

James Episcopal Church in Hackettstown and sang in its choir. He was a former member of St. Stephen Church in Beverly.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Nancy White Jones, in 1998.

Surviving are a daughter, Pamela Layton and husband Ron of Westminster, S.C.; a son, retired Navy Capt. Clifton and wife Margaret of Lansdowne, Va.; and several nieces and nephews.

Services were held April 23 at St. James Church. Interment was in Monument Cemetery, Beverly.
