Charlotte W. Kayhart, 80, died Jan. 1 at the Beth Israel Medical Center in New York after a short illness.

Kayhart lived in Hackettstown, before moving to Newton in 1941. She graduated from the Mount Sinai Hospital School of Nursing in New York.

She was a nurse, and anaesthetist and a public health specialist. Kayhart was last employed as the welfare director of Public Assistance in Green Township, until retiring in 1970.

She helped organize the Sussex County Public Health and School Nurses Association.

Interment was at the Union Cemetery in Hackettstown. Funeral arrangements were done by Smith-McCracken Funeral Home in Newton.
